

## **GOLF FACILITY DRESS CODE**

**Revised 10/27/15**

The Overlake golf course dress code reflects respected golf traditions while being cognizant of fashion changes. Customary golf attire is required on the golf course, practice green and driving range. Please wear clean, tailored, respectable clothing the way it is designed to be worn. Exceptions for special events will be noted on event announcements. In order to ensure a pleasant experience, please be sure that your guests are aware of the dress code. The Pro Shop staff will enforce the dress code on behalf of the Board of Trustees and the golf membership. \* Note: When playing in an outside tournament or at another club remember to check their dress code.

### **Appropriate for Men: (Please look respectable.)**

- Shirts must have a collar and sleeves. Please tuck in shirts that are designed to be tucked in.
- Sweaters, golf sweatshirts, mock turtleneck and turtlenecks are acceptable
- Slacks and shorts must have a zipper. Slacks or shorts that have belt loops must be worn with a belt.
- Shorts must be appropriate length
- Hats and visors are to be worn bill forward

### **Appropriate for Women: (Please look respectable.)**

- Shirts must have a collar and/or sleeves. Please tuck in shirts that are designed to be tucked in.
- Sweaters, golf sweatshirts, mock turtleneck and turtlenecks are acceptable
- Slacks, golf skirts, shorts or skorts are acceptable. No "short" shorts.
- Shorts, skirts, and skorts must be appropriate length
- Hats and visors are to be worn bill forward

### **Inappropriate and prohibited attire for Men and Women:**

- Unkempt clothing
- Blue Jeans
- Non-golf workout attire
- Shoes with metal spikes
